REFERRAL PROGRAM

Refer a friend or family and receive \$10 off your first two months tuition + waived registration fee if applicable.

LATE FEE

Tuition is due the first week of every month. If payments are made after this, a \$15 late fee will be applied to every week in which the payment is late.

BOUNCED CHECKS

If there is a bounced check due to insufficient funds, there will be a \$20 fee applied. This will need to be paid within a week of its issue.

REGISTRATION FEES

A one time registration fee is applied for all NEW dancers to DYNAMYX. Returning dancers do not owe a registration fee. This is calculated for the total number of dancers in a family registering. This fee is due with the first months tuition due by September 12th.

Please see the breakdown below:

DANCE PROGRAM & ACRO TUITION

Tuition is due the first week of every month and is calculated by dancer, not by family. Total tuition will be the sum of all classes dancers are enrolled in at a flat non discounted rate. Example: 1 student enrolled in 3 dance program classes = tuition of \$120 / month.

Dance Program pricing: \$40 / month per class Acro Program pricing: \$50 / month per class

*August and September Tuition will be combined this season

Automatic Withdrawal: Can be selected upon registering and payments will be withdrawn on the 15th of every month. You will receive an email at the beginning of the season to verify if you would like to proceed with autmatic withdrawal of payments if this is something you had selected during the registration process.

Trimester payments are made in September, December and March. This gives you a 5% discount for choosing this form of payment. These payments do not include costume fees, registration fees and recital fees, these are added separately.

Yearly payments are made in August. This payment does not include costume fees, registration fees and recital fees, these are added separately. This form of payment gives you a 10% discount.

COSTUME FEE

Costume fees are calculated per dancer and per class. (For example, if you have two dancers each in two classes, you will owe 4 costume fees for the 4 total classes.) Costume fees are due the first week of October and are not included in the yearly or trimester payment amount. This fee covers your dancers costumes and tights (if applicable) for the classes they are in. If your dancer is enrolled in our teen or senior hip hop classes, the costume fee covers the costume and shoes for those respected classes. Technique and Acro classes will no have a costume fee associated.

RECITAL FEE

This fee is calculated per family. Recital fee includes 5 tickets to the end of year recital. Additional tickets to recital can be purchased at the end of the season when additional tickets go on sale. Recital fee is \$50 and due the first week of November.

REFUND POLICY

Payments made while dancers are enrolled and attending class will not be refunded. If your dancer decides not to continue after costume and recital fees have been paid, you will be refunded this money back. Tuition will not be refunded.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Make sure all belongings have the dancers first and last names on them, shoes do not need to have names visible on the outside of the shoe, but can have them on the inside. We are NOT responsible for lost items. All items that have not been claimed within 2 weeks of being found will be donated to Goodwill.

CLASS ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

We ask that dancers arrive 5 - 10 min early to all scheduled classes, but no earlier. We will dismiss classes right at end of class time. Dancers need to be picked up right away from classes so our lobby stays flowing smoothly. We ask that only one parent walks dancers in if needed and can wait in lobby or in car until dancers end of class time.

FRONT DESK

We ask that the front desk is used only when absolutely necessary and for payments only. Please log in to your online account for payments to be made for tuition etc. Checks can be sent in with your dancer to class.

POSITIVE ENVIRONMENT

Kind, positive and respectful behavior is an expectation in class and in our studio. Disrespectful behavior of any kind will be addressed, this includes eye rolling, talking back and not following directions. If this is a continued behavior, parents will be notified, and further action may be taken. Our classes are very structured, and we instruct as a dance school, we expect dancers to follow directions, listen and be respectful to those around them and towards the instructors at the studio.

SNOW / COLD DAYS

Cancellations due to weather will be made based upon a combination of CBSD closings and weather reports. We do not always cancel when schools cancel. Please make sure you check your emails, our social media pages and allow our text messages to be notified of cancelations based on weather. There are only makeups offered if there are more than 2 snow/cold days for a specific day that have been cancelled.

EXCESSIVE ABSENCES

Please make sure dancers arrive only 5 - 10 minutes before their scheduled class time and are prepared for class.

If a dancer is more than 5 minutes late and we were not notified beforehand, dancers will have to miss class for that day.

Tardiness is a distraction to the learning process. If a dancer will be late for a class, please email or call the studio so we can make note of this. If a dancer will be absent, please make sure you call at least 2 hours ahead of time so we can make note of their absence.

Being in class is important to not only your dancers learning but to the class as well. Please make sure dancer is not missing more than 2 classes a month. There are no make up classes for absences.

FOOD & DRINK

Food and drink will not be allowed in the studio. Water is allowed, but must be labeled with dancers first and last name on them.

MAKE UP CLASSES

Make up classes will **not** be held for missed classes on the dancers part. Please email us in advance if your dancer will be absent.

CLASS VIEWING

There is no viewing of classes allowed under any circumstances. There will be one scheduled parent viewing week during the season where family members can view dancer/dancers classes.

LOBBY

We ask that the lobby and waiting area is kept clean and quiet and that the amount of people in the designated areas are kept to a minimum.

Be considerate of other customers as well as our students while in the lobby or viewing areas of the studio. Just as you can hear some of the instructions coming from inside the studio, dancers and instructors inside the studio can hear loud noises from the lobby. Siblings of students must be supervised at all times within the walls of DYNAMYX Dance Company. There should be no running, yelling or playing with trophies, furniture or merchandise in the lobby.

CODE OF CONDUCT

To ensure a safe running and enjoyable experience by all, you will find our code of conduct expectations below. We are setting in place a zero tolerance policy for both students and parents, meaning that if any students and/or parents breach our studios' code of conduct, we reserve the rights for immediate removal from DYNAMYX Dance Company.

Parents can approach directors/staff members about questions or concerns regarding costumes, information, child sickness etc. If there are private issues/concerns, please address these via email and they will be handled in that manner, as this takes away from other students that deserve our attention.

In the case of a parent showing disrespect or defamation to any parent, staff or students, an immediate dismissal could take place. Physical, emotional, or cyber bullying to any staff member, parents or students will not be tolerated and could also result in dismissal from DYNAMYX Dance Company.

TAP (AGES 5 +)

HIP HOP (AGES 5+)
